

Hydrovac Excavation

Hydrovac is an efficient method of non-destructive excavation, that removes earth by using high pressure water and a powerful vacuum.

The high pressure water loosens the ground while the vacuum simultaneously extracts the debris into a single tank mounted on a truck.

Hydrovac excavation can be performed on all ground types, such as clay, sand, and gravel.

Hydrovac is suitable in gas, power, waterlines, fibre optic, and industrial or construction works.
